2019/023

Resolved that minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 17 January 2019 were agreed as being a true and accurate representation of that meeting and signed by the Chairman.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE LAST MEETING

2019/024

There were no matters arising from the minutes of the last meeting.

COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT

2019/025

County Councillor Cherry Brooks had sent apologies for the meeting and District Councillor Quinn reported on her behalf.

DISTRICT COUNCILLORS REPORT

2019/026

a) District Councillor Barry Quinn reported on the Local Government Reorganisation: The Dorset Shadow Council agreed the constitution for the new Dorset Council. Briefings for the budget had taken place and the budget was currently balanced, this will need to be reviewed.
A large number of parents protested the cuts to special needs funding. This is a demand-led service so if it goes over budget the money is found from somewhere. It was acknowledged that the issue needs to be raised with central government.
The external communication campaign launched on 1st February to raise public awareness of the new Dorset Council.
The Shadow Executive met and recommended the Emergency Plan for Dorset for approval, it needs to be in place from day one.

There has been debate about the Dorset Local Plan which needs to be in place by 2023. It will be an amalgamation of all the district and borough plans. There is an issue of resources due to a national shortage of planning officers.

b) The Purbeck Local Plan was submitted to the Inspector in January and now has more weight. New development in Swanage had conditions applied which reflect the second homes policy within the Plan.

c) PDC Policy Group met in January but there was no substantive business.

d) Missed bin collections should be reported on the Dorsetforyou website and a report will then be generated back to say when it will be collected.

MATTERS ARISING

2019/027

a) Standing Orders amendments were noted.

b) A replacement roundel needs to be decided for the fingerpost. There is a price list for letters and the boards need to be refurbished. A new post is required and this could be provided by AONB or Dorset County Council.

The dog bin will need to be re-sited and it was agreed that stickers should be placed on the waste bin at the bus shelter to inform people that dog waste can be deposited there, in line with Dorset Waste Partnership guidelines.

c) Elections for the new Dorset Council and parish and town councils within Dorset are due to take place on Thursday 2nd May 2019. Nomination papers are available for candidates to complete. A report was given by the Clerk to inform potential candidates on how to complete the nomination paper and
