TWA/2019/167 6 East Chaldon, DT2 8DN: There were objection to the application to fell a Willow tree.

TWA/2019/156 Bus Shelter, East Chaldon: There were no objections to the application to crown lift a Sycamore to give clearance to bus shelter.

TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAY

b) Cllr Middlehurst pointed out the 'passing place' sign was no longer in position at the top of Five Marys and cars were now parking there which restricted the passing place.

d) Cllr Guthrie informed the meeting that he had been periodically reporting blocked drains in Chydyok Road and Highways had been attending.

b) Cllr Guthrie raised the ongoing issue of parking in Chydyok Road and suggested moving the hedge back into the paddock. Cllr Watkins responded that this had been attempted previously but Dorset County Council had prevented it as there was a concern about possible increase of water egress. It was agreed that discussion with relevant parties should commence again.
